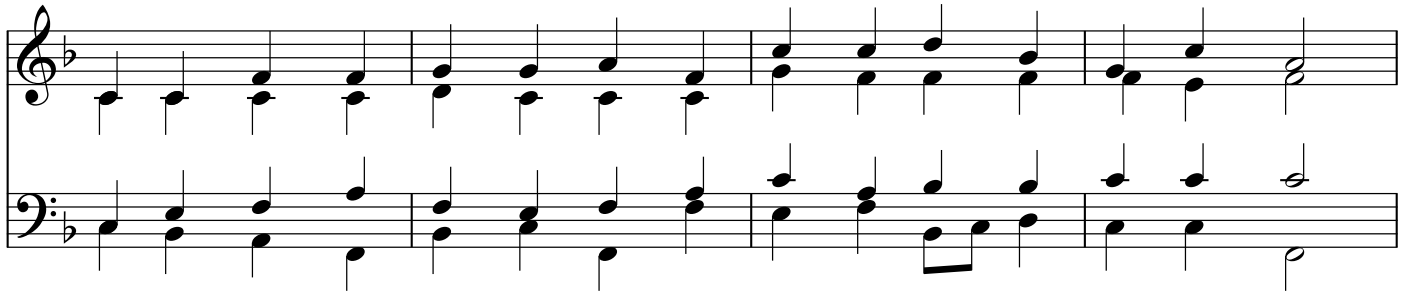


# 325 • God, My King, Thy Might Confessing,
