




and\_ this was all their\_ teach - ing, in eve - ry deed and word,


to all a - like pro - claim - ing one\_ Church, one Faith, one Lord.

3. And we, shall we be faith - less? shall\_ hearts fail, hands hang down?


shall\_ we e - vade the\_ con - flict, and cast a - way our crown?

Not\_ so: in God's deep\_ coun - sels some bet - ter thing is stored;


we will main - tain, un - flinch - ing, one\_ Church, one Faith, one Lord.




4. Thy mer - cy will not fail us, nor leave thy work un - done;
