A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

Peter proceeded to address [the relatives and friends of Cornelius] in these words: “I begin to see how true it is that God shows no partiality. Rather, ~~the man~~ <sup>person</sup> of any nation who fears God and acts uprightly ~~is~~ acceptable to him.”

Peter had not finished these words when the Holy Spirit descended upon all who were listening to Peter’s message. The circumcised ~~believers~~ <sup>these</sup> who had accompanied Peter were surprised that the gift of the Holy Spirit should have been poured out on the Gentiles also, whom they could hear speaking in tongues and glorifying God. Peter put the question at that point: “What can stop these people who have received the Holy Spirit, even as we have, from being baptized with water?” So he gave orders that they be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. After this was done, they asked him to stay with them for a few days.
