








I will extol you, O LORD, for you drew me clear and did not let my e-nemies rejoice over me.




O LORD, you brought me up from the netherworld; you preserved me from among those going




down into the pit. **I will praise...**



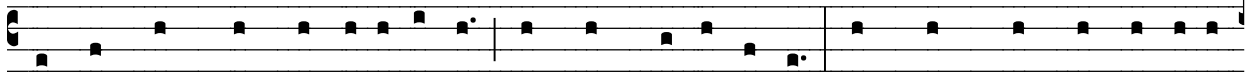
Sing praise to the LORD, you his faithful ones, and give thanks to his holy name. For his anger



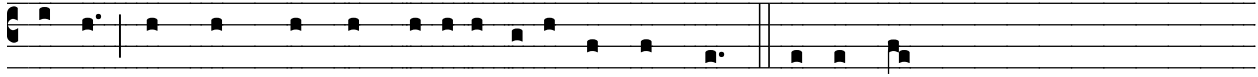
lasts but a moment; a lifetime, his good will. At nightfall, weeping enters in, but with the dawn,
