# Eighth Sunday After Pentecost

## A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

**A**cting in a political way, letting someone else think that you are interested in them when you actually have your own agenda, is never good. It is based on the vices of deception, pride and human respect.

Unfortunately it is more common in society and in any administration (including the Church), than we could imagine.

Our Lord is not telling us to be political in order to secure our salvation in the parable today.

On the contrary, we cannot deceive God. If we wish to give to Him as He desires, we need to serve Him, truthfully. If we serve Him as He wishes it is not human respect. If we give glory to Him it is not pride.

Thus if we are "political" toward God in order to guarantee our salvation, it does not stem from vice, but rather is good for our soul.
