A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

The greater the bond of love, the greater the hurt from an offense. Even if the offense be an action that in itself is much smaller, because of the bond of love there is a much greater offense.

For example, a husband and wife could be sitting at a restaurant. The husband could look at the wife in a depreciatory way. This could offend her more than a waiter accidentally dropping a tray of food on her.

If we apply this to your average criticism, the person being judged oftentimes was unaware of what he or she had even done. Whereas the person finding the offense serious enough to broadcast obviously is not without sin themselves.

Although their sins may be “small” compared to the sin they are criticizing, the very fact that they are scandalized enough to talk about the sins of others shows that the love they have for God makes their sin all the worse.

The same can be said in the context of the parable today. Let’s take a simple sin. If someone swears at us, it is nothing compared to if we were to swear at God. The exact same sin, but a very different recipient. The offenses we have received and for which we exact “justice” are nothing compared to the sins with which we offend Our Lord, and for which we cry for mercy.

We have a new app! We have a unique situation in the FSSP apostolate of Los Angeles, that we do not have a church of our own. In order to build a stronger community in spite of this disability we have created a manner to stay connected online. This has been what we call “The Table”. It has served us well, because it is a way to stay informed about the progress of the project, build up our community, also unite all of us from the many different areas around the city of Los Angeles, as well as build a community of friends that stretches far throughout the world! With 570 members (most representing families, not individuals) The Table was a strong online community!

Well, the bad news is that the development team that has been providing the service of The Table is discontinuing. Faced with finding an alternative, after much search, there is simply not another good computer-based system like we had.

Solution? We have gone with a smart phone app, that works on Android, iPhone, iPad and Android tablets. If you go to the App Store or the Google Play Store and search for FSSPLA you will find the app.



This app works in a similar way to The Table - except on your phone instead of the computer. There is a calendar of upcoming events, you can post as we did on The Table, you can message each other directly and it actually works better than The Table! In the end you won't need to be at your computer to be connected with the FSSP of LA Community. Posts ding your phone like text messages, so you are always immediately informed! (You can modify the notifications as you wish if you don't like this).
