## A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

**B**y their fruits you shall know them” - is what Our Divine Master tells us today.

A good example of seeing the fruits of a good seed would be the spiritual fruits abounding in Extraordinary Form Latin Mass apostolates. You come into church and you feel like you are in a house of prayer, not a conference hall. You hear the grunts, mumblings and cries of life from the little children. You see the youth who congregate after Mass with their wholesome friends.

Before Mass you see everyone line up to clean their soul in the confessional. After Mass you see people praying their thanksgiving. You see people with scapulars on, women with heads covered, men in ties. People are here for God.

Usually the bad fruits from a Latin Mass community come from a lack of cooperation with grace - a sense of righteousness where one thinks one is holy because one is surrounded by holy things, and criticizes others who seem less holy. Or sins of pride or other sloth-inspired sins. However usually the bad fruits of a Latin Mass community are of no fault of the sources of grace that abound.

We should give God gratitude for providing us with a wholesome atmosphere in which to let our faith grow.

Not everyone has this opportunity, and many people are trying to become holy in atmospheres that really don't inspire much hope.
