There's three reasons to keep Sunday holy. One, that it be a day dedicated for the praise of God. Next for our rest, and also for time with our family. Let's not be asking what we can get away with doing on Sunday. Let's rest, and give the day to God.

The following announcement of Fr Fryar was posted on the FSSPLA app, regarding app usage rules.

So I need to do some serious pruning here on the App. It happens with every church bulletin board, that it tends to get filled up with a bunch of good things so that nobody can find the important things.

I've actually been thinking and praying about this for several months now - several. And I've been trying to come up with a set of rules for the app. I've been toying with the idea of reserving it for admins only, or of eliminating comments, but I do want to give certain freedom for its use because it does help us grow in friendship and get to know each other.

That said, however, I do not want the app to be "FSSPLA Facebook". Many people using the app do not have Facebook, precisely because it could be said that the platform of Facebook is not conducive to virtue. Now if they do not have Facebook, why force them into it by bringing Facebook to the FSSPLA app?

So, moving forward I want to lay down the following rules. I may add to these rules later but for now I feel that these will suffice. Again, I've prayed a lot about this.

- 1) Prayer requests, photos and news pertaining to FSSP of LA are welcomed and encouraged.
- 2) No links to anything already posted on the web. The exception to this rule is if one of the admins decides to post something. Currently the admins are the priests. If you think that it is something of importance, you can send the link to an admin to see if he thinks it should be posted.
- 3) (This is a difficult one because this content is good but..) No more Saint of the Day. There's nothing wrong with the posts of the Saint of the Day, however it's just too much stuff on the app and we need to clean it up.
- 4) It's fine to post about Latin Masses happening in the Los Angeles area to let everyone know before the event. The city is big and we should support every (legitimate) Latin Mass and grow our Latin Mass communities around the city. However let's just confine this to announcements BEFORE the event - let's not post updates or photos after the event, because the app is for FSSP of LA. Again, it's not Facebook.

I hope that the app gets cleaned up by these rules. Currently there are many people who have blocked the app or parts of it because there's just too many alerts ringing on their phone and too much stuff to weed through when they open the app. It's not necessary to have hundreds of things on the app each day. What is necessary is that announcements and prayers for our community have a platform to be transmitted on, and that's what the app should be.
