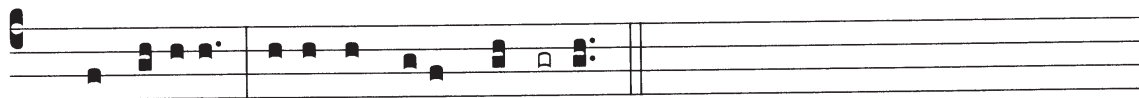

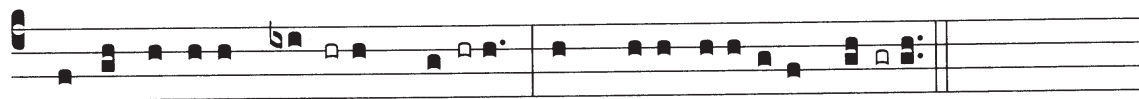
All stand for the MAGNIFICAT and ✠ make the sign of the cross

Cantor A intones, men finish verse 1; Ladies sing verse 2; men verse 3; and so on:

3. Quia respéxit humilitátem ancíllæ súæ : \* ecce enim ex hoc beátam me  
dicent ómnes generatiónes.

4. Quia fécit míhi mágna qui pótens est : \* et sánctum nómen éjus.

5. Et misericórdia éjus a progénie in progénies \* timéntibus éum.

6. Fécit poténtiam in bráchio súo : \* dispersit superbos ménte cordis súi.

7. Depósuit poténtes de séde, \* et exaltávit húmiles.

8. Esuriéntes implévit bónis : \* et dívites dimísit inánes.

9. Suscépit Israël púerum súum, \* recordátus misericórdiæ súæ.

10. Sicut locútus est ad pátres nóstros, \* Abraham et sémini éjus in sácula.

Stand as Cantor A intones Gloria until asterisk (men finish, then ladies sing verse 12) :

11. Glória Pátri, et Fílio, \* et Spirítui Sáncto.

12. Sicut érat in princípío, et nunc, et sémpet, \* et in sácula sæculórum.
