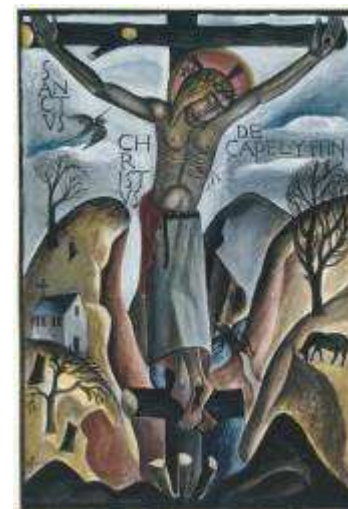

A degree of rhythmic flexibility is expected, paying due respect to the words set. Tenuto marks (a short horizontal line under or over a note) suggest no more than a *slight* lengthening.
