

SEVEN PLAINSONG ANTIPHONS FOR THE HOLY THURSDAY WASHING OF FEET BY ARISTOTLE A. ESGUERRA

After the Homily, where a pastoral reason suggests it, the Washing of Feet follows.

The men who have been chosen are led by the ministers to seats prepared in a suitable place. Then the priest (removing his chausuble if necessary) goes to each one, and, with the help of the ministers, pours water over each one's feet and then dries them.

Meanwhile some of the following antiphons or other appropriate chants are sung.



Antiphon 1 *Postquam surrexit Dominus* *cf. Jn 13: 4, 5, 15*



Antiphon 2 *Dominus Iesus* *Jn 13: 12, 13, 15*






LOrd, * are you to wash my feet? Jesus said to him in answer: If I do not wash your feet, you will have no share


