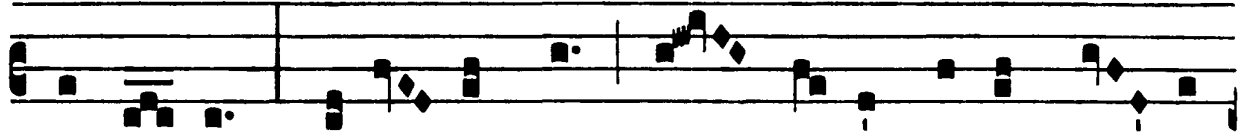

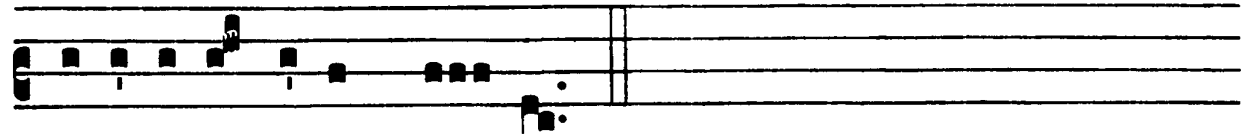

Repeat the Antiphon Asperges me.

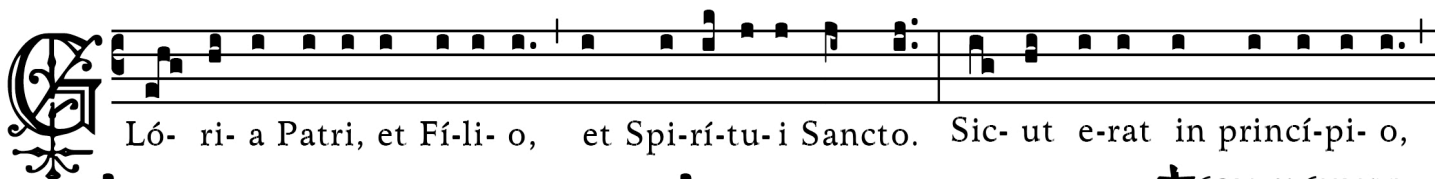
On Passion Sunday and Palm Sunday, the Glória Patri is not said, but the Antiphon Asperges me is repeated immediately after the Psalm.

Translation

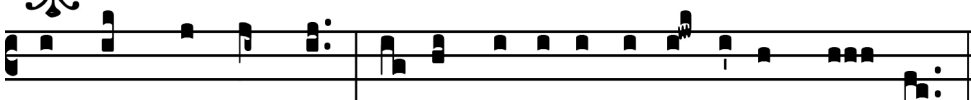
Thou shalt sprinkle me with hyssop, O Lord, and I shall be cleansed;
