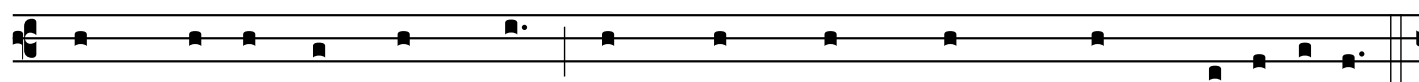


Introit (Wis 1: 7; Ps 67: 2)
