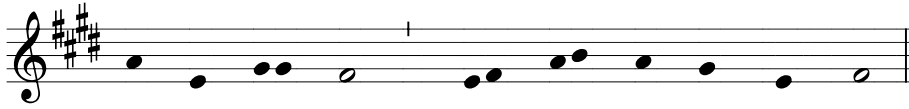

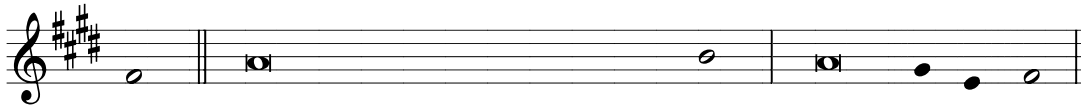
## Responsorial Psalm Psalm 40: 2, 4, 7-8, 8-9, 10



Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.

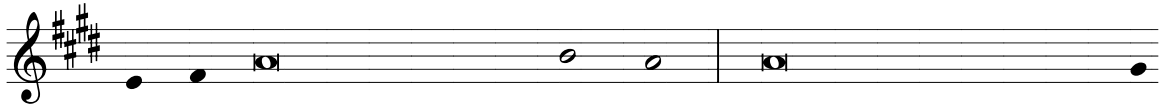


I have waited, waited for the LORD, and he *stooped* toward me and heard my

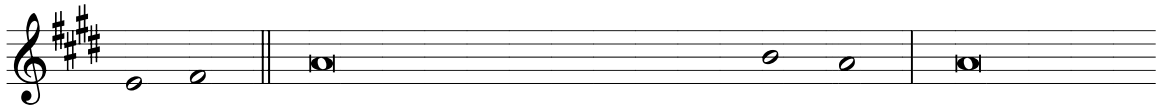


cry. And he put a *new* song into my mouth, a hymn to our God.

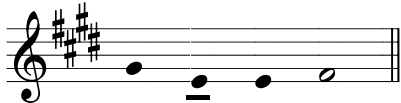
