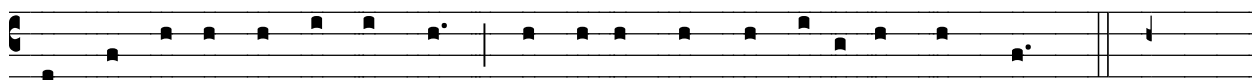

Ps 93: 1, 1-2, 5



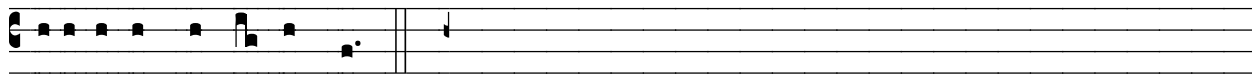
He Lord is king; he is robed in majesty.



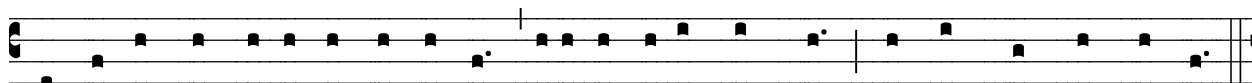
The LORD is king, in splendor robed; robed is the LORD and girt about with strength.
