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#### P R E F A C E

This easily learned composition has been one of the most widely known and loved of all musical vehicles for the text of the mass in the United States. Its lyricism and harmonic beauty are simple but effective ingredients as devoted voices create a prayer in folksong style to participate in the celebration of the sacred rite of the mass.

In this particular edition, the music has been slightly changed from the original to fit more perfectly the newly approved English text. Suggested phrases for a cantor and congregation are designated in the top (soprano voice) line. The choir parts will embellish the performance and help lead the people in sung prayers.

By beginning with known favorite music, congregations will be encouraged to sing and later, perhaps, may be more easily induced to undertake the performance of more ancient classics or more modern compositions.

Another American favorite - the Mass of St. Francis by John Singenberger - is suggested for adoption as an alternate work, to introduce a different type of melodic look, but none-the-less attractive composition for today's congregations and choirs.
