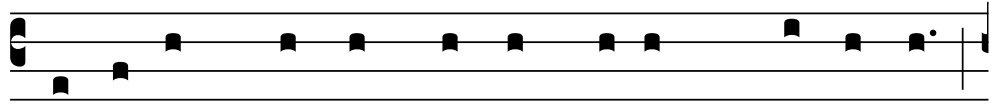

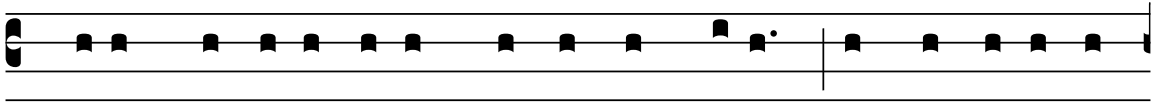

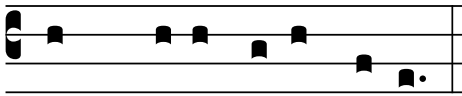

for the Lord hath worked wonders. ALLELUIA.

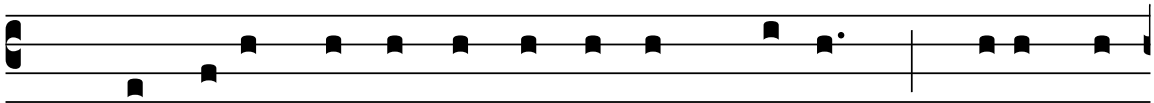

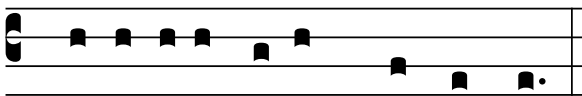
