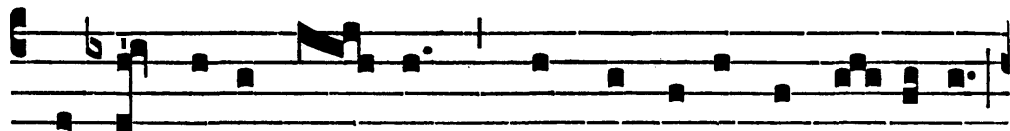


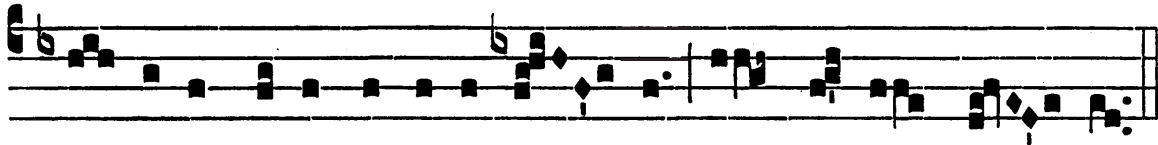

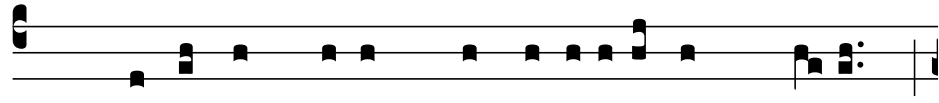

THE PREFACE TO THE VATICAN EDITION READS AS FOLLOWS:

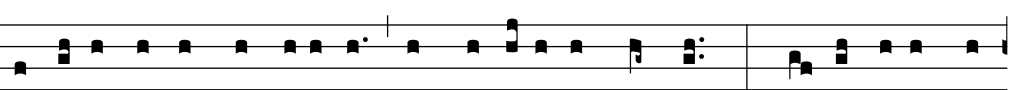

It is to be noted that B-flat, when it occurs, only holds good as far as the next natural (\natural) or dividing line, OR NEW WORD.

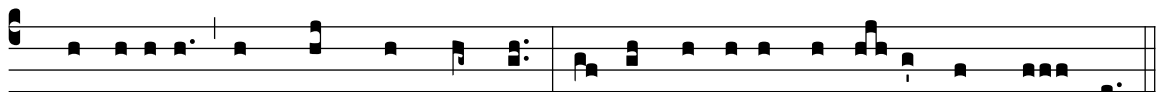
