A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

“**A**dvent is a time for penance. This we see from the purple vestments, the lack of the Gloria, and in the Divine Office there are other additional prayers that the Church prays at times of penance.

But these prayers and even the atmosphere in the church is very different to the other penitential time of Lent. While in Lent we are sorrowful and concentrating on our sins and our suffering Savior, Advent is filled with joy and hope.

The texts of the liturgy rejoice that Our Redeemer is coming. Even in the streets we see lights and wish blessings to each other for the upcoming feast of Christmas.

This, incidentally, is how penance is supposed to be! Penance should restrict our bodies from the pleasures they indulge in, so that our souls can be free to seek the Good (God) that our hearts desire.

This we see in Advent. In fact we see it a little more today, with the slightly lighter vestments and the joyful texts.

If we were to translate the liturgical texts of Advent into one line, it would go something like: “Don’t bother me you things of earth and let my soul rejoice that My Lord, the joy of my soul, is coming!”
