THE 54 DAY ROSARY NOVENA

After many novenas, it seems that a few faithful prayer warriors persevere in prayer, while not everyone is aware of our efforts. The rosaries prayed before Mass each day are a continuation of these novenas. In a renewed effort, please join us as we begin the sixteenth 54 Day Novena this Wednesday.

How it works is simple. You begin day one with the Joyful Mysteries. Day two Sorrowful, three is Glorious, day four Joyful, and keep the rotation going. As the novena progresses you complete three sets of nine (three novenas) in petition, then three sets of nine (three novenas) in thanksgiving.

We are confident that Our Blessed Mother will hear our prayers and find us benefactors and a church. At the same time, it is a blessing to know that the FSSP parish of Los Angeles has been entirely founded on this bed of spiritual roses, created by thousands and thousands of rosaries prayed by our members.
