HOW MUCH SHOULD I PLEDGE?

We could divide the levels of giving into three, and these are variable according to the finances and lifestyle of each individual rather than a specific dollar amount:

CHARITABLE: Giving the amount that you would spend on coffee or a magazine subscription each month.

SACRIFICIAL: Giving the amount that you would spend on a car payment each month - this would be the normal level of giving toward a new church.

HEROIC: Giving the amount that you would spend on a house payment each month.
