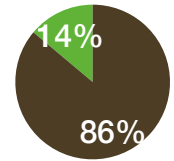
MAKE A PLEDGE!

HOW MUCH SHOULD I PLEDGE?

Each of us should be prudent but grateful with the money that God has given us. With that as the general rule, we should provide for the needs of our family, and then weigh the spiritual needs of our family over the wants that we otherwise would have. We could divide the levels of giving into three, and these are variable according to the finances and lifestyle of each individual rather than a specific dollar amount:

CHARITABLE: Giving the amount that you would spend on coffee or a magazine subscription each month.

SACRIFICIAL: Giving the amount that you would spend on a car payment each month - this would be the normal level of giving toward a new church.

HEROIC: Giving the amount that you would spend on a house payment each month.
