A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

Fittingly, this Feast Day splits the Liturgical Year in two. Before today we walked through the life of Our Lord, conforming our souls to how He lived.

After today we will study the teachings of Our Divine Master and conform our souls to what He taught.

Splitting this division of the Liturgical Year in half is the Feast of the Trinity. Rather than being a divider, in reality it is the culmination point, the center of everything else.

Because in the end, all came from God and should return back to God. From Him came all good things we have and to Him we should return.

On any given day you can see how the Trinity is the center of the Liturgy, and even the center of our prayers, if we pray in the traditional way.

We begin and end our prayers *In the Name of the Father..* Each mystery of the Rosary concludes with the *Gloria Patri.*

At Holy Mass and in the Divine Office pretty much every prayer concludes with an invocation of the Trinity, and like the threefold *Kyrie*, the impression of the Trinity is stamped all over the Liturgy.

Let us keep the Trinity in our hearts, and not ignore the central seat the Trinity has in our prayers and in our Faith. In the end we will rejoice, giving glory to Him for all eternity. May all glory be given to Him, Whom alone deserves all the glory!

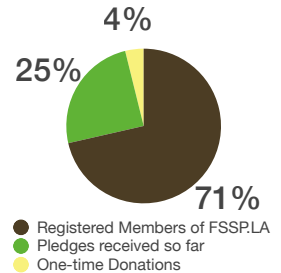
MAKE A PLEDGE!

We could divide the levels of giving into three, and these are variable according to the finances and lifestyle of each individual rather than a specific dollar amount:

CHARITABLE: Giving the amount that you would spend on coffee or a magazine subscription each month.

SACRIFICIAL: Giving the amount that you would spend on a car payment each month - this would be the normal level of giving toward a new church.

HEROIC: Giving the amount that you would spend on a house payment each month.
