GRADUAL & ALLELUIA. Ps 79: 2-3 & Ps 79: 2


Qui sedes, Dómine, super Chérubim, éxcita poténtiam tuam, et veni. *Ÿ*. Qui regis Israëġ, inténde: qui dedúcis, velut ovem, Joseph.

Thou O Lord, that sittest upon the cherubim, stir up Thy might, and come. *Ÿ*. Give ear, O Thou that rulest Israel: Thou that leadest Joseph like a sheep.


