
Allelúja, allelúja. *ŷ.* Dominus dixit ad me: Filius meus es tu, ego hodie genui te. Allelúja.

Alleluia, alleluia. *ŷ.* The Lord hath said to Me: Thou art My Son, this day have I begotten Thee. Alleluia.


