**Psalm Verse no. 1**

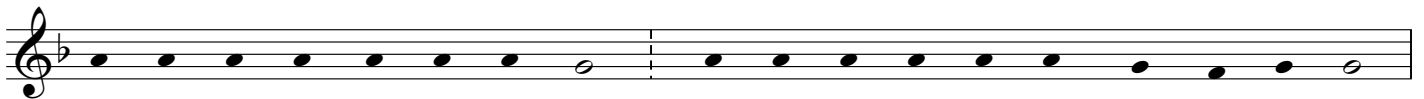


Come, let us sing joy - ful - ly **to** the Lord; let us ac-claim the Rock of our **sal** - va - tion.

**Psalm Verse no. 2**

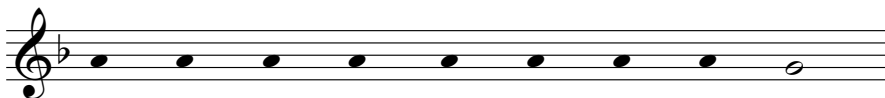


Come, let us bow down in wor-**ship**; let us kneel be - fore the **Lord** who made us.
