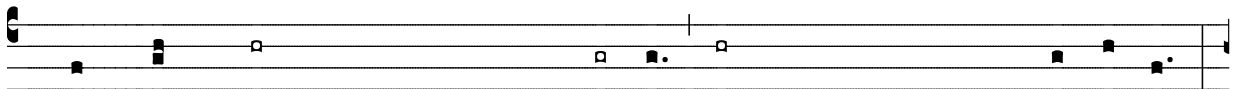
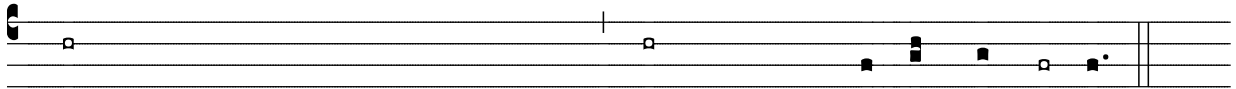




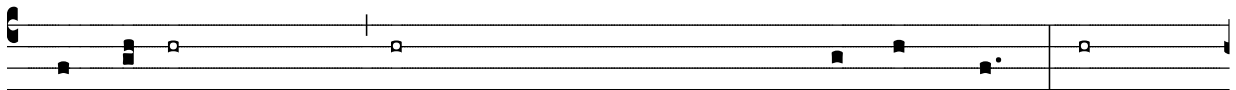
The just man is a light in dark-ness to the up- right.



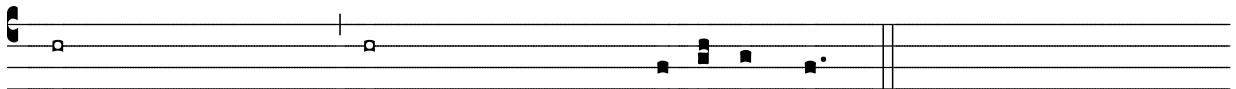
Light shines through the darkness for the *up*-right; he is gracious and merci-*ful* and just.



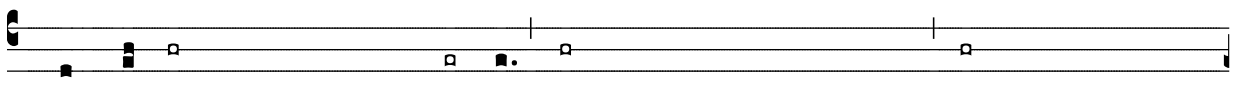
Well for the man who is gracious and lends, who conducts his *af*-fairs with jus-tice.  $\text{R}$



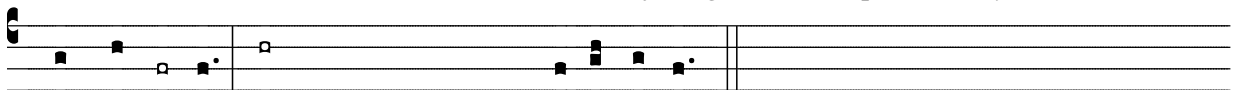
He shall never be moved; the just one shall be in everlasting *re*-mem-*brance*. An evil
