The Westminster Version of the Sacred Scriptures was produced by Roman Catholics in England. Its general editor was Father Caraman. If bears an Imprimatur dated 15 March 1958 by the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Westminster, an Imprimi Potest by the director of the *Pontifical Biblical Institute* in Rome. A special letter commending this particular Bible was written for it by Pope Pius XII.
