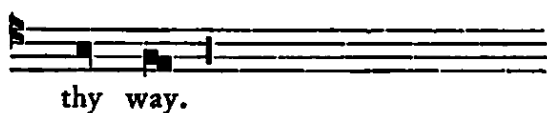
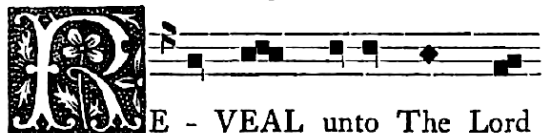
Monday at Lauds.
