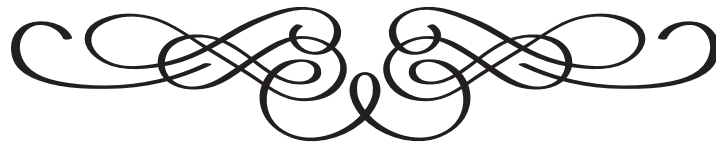

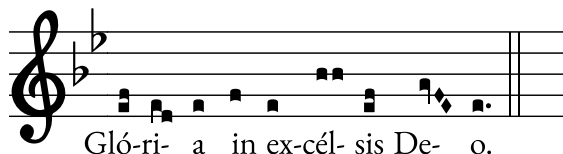
Score according to the official rhythm, mandated by Pope Saint Pius X.
