Psalms for Communion.

7. Quóniam tu percussisti  
ómnes adversántes míhi síne  
cáusa : \* déntes peccatórum  
contrívísti.

8. Dómini est sálus : \* et  
super pópulum túum benedíctio  
túa.

7. For thou hast struck all them  
who are my adversaries without  
cause : thou hast broken the teeth

### Psalm 32.

*Praise to the Lord, all-powerful helper of his people.*

1. Exsultáte, jústi, in Dó-  
mino : \* réctos decet collau-  
dátio.

2. Confitémini Dómino in  
cithara : \* in psalterio decem  
chordárum psállite illi.

3. Cantáte éi cánticum nó-  
vum : \* bene psállite éi in  
vociferatióne.

4. Quia réctum est vèrbum  
Dómini, \* et ómnia ópera éjus  
in fíde.

5. Diligit misericórdiam et  
judícium : \* misericórdia Dó-  
mini pléna est térra.

6. Vèrbo Dómini caéli fir-  
máti sunt : \* et spírítu oris éjus  
ómnis vírtus eórum.

1. Rejoice in the Lord, O ye  
just : praise becometh the upright.

2. Give praise to the Lord on the  
harp ; sing to him with the psaltery,  
the instrument of ten strings.

3. Sing to him a new canticle :  
sing well unto him with a loud noise.

4. For the word of the Lord is  
right : and all his works are done  
with faithfulness.

5. He loveth mercy and judgment ;  
the earth is full of the mercy of the  
Lord.

6. By the word of the Lord the  
heavens were established ; and all  
the power of them by the spirit of  
his mouth :

12. Beáta gens cújus est  
Dóminus Déus éjus : \* pópulus  
quem elégit in hereditátem síbi.

13. De caélo respéxit Dó-  
minus : \* vidit ómnes filios  
hóminum.

14. De praeparáto habitáculo  
súo : \* respéxit super ómnes,  
qui hábitant térram.

15. Qui finxit singillátim cór-  
da eórum : \* qui intélligit ómnia  
ópera eórum.

12. Blessed is the nation whose  
God is the Lord : the people whom  
he hath chosen for his inheritance.

13. The Lord hath looked from  
heaven : he hath beheld all the sons  
of men.

14. From the place of his habi-  
tation he looketh forth upon all the  
inhabitants of the earth,

15. He that fashioneth the hearts  
of them all, that considereth all their  
works.
