let thy faithful servants bless thee;
- 11 **L**et them publish the glory of thy kingdom,  
and discourse of thy power,
- 15 **Q**uietly, Lord, thy creatures raise their eyes to thee,  
and thou grantest them, in due time, their nourishment,
- 16 **R**eady to open thy hand,  
and fill with thy blessing all that lives.
- 17 **S**o faithful the Lord is in all he does,  
so gracious in all his dealings.
- 18 **T**he Lord draws near to every man that calls upon him,  
will he but call upon him with a true heart.
