R. Ecclesiae proprium continentium, prout ab ipsomet Pontifice restitutus fuit, Commissio Pontificia, mandata et desideria eiusdem Pontificis adimplens, ipsam editionem summo studio ac diligentia paravit, atque perfecit.

Haec vero S.
