SUMMARY OF POSITION

The Director of Sacred Music is a full-time position and is supervised by the pastor of Queen of Peace. The full-time position includes part-time teaching sacred music in the school and part-time organizing and directing the Parish Sacred Music. It is preferred that candidates also be able to serve as organist. Queen of Peace Catholic Church is a growing parish with a rich history. We have a prek-8th grade Classical Curriculum school.
