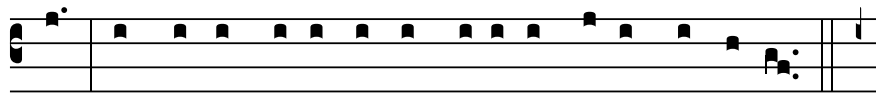


# Sunday within the Christmas Octave

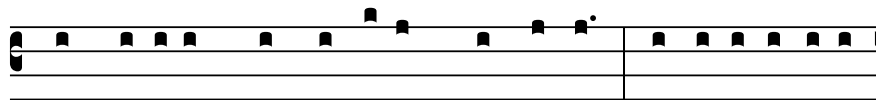
INTROIT. Wis 18: 14-15
