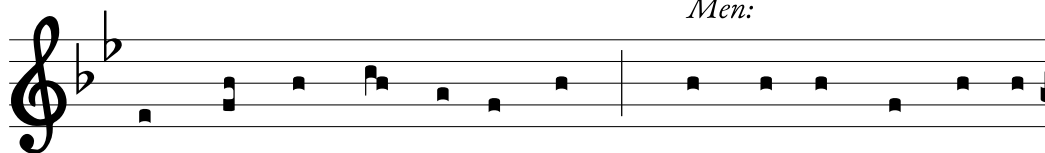

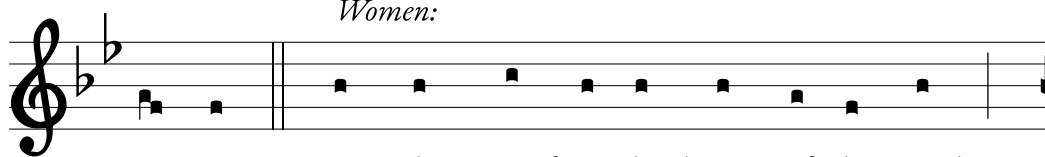

IVE praise to *name* of the Lord; praise it, you *that* are his



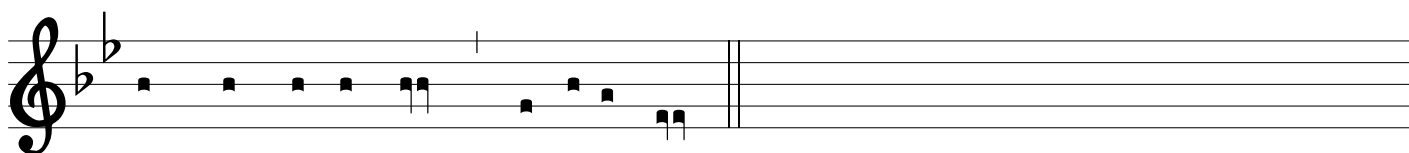
Women:
