

NUPTIAL MASS • During Eastertide, the Nuptial Gradual (“Uxor Tua”) is not sung. In its place is sung the Lesser Alleluia (“Mittat Vobis”), which is followed by the Greater Alleluia (below):

Alleluia. √. May the Lord out of Sion bless you; He that made heaven and earth. Alleluia.
Allelúja. √. Benedicat vobis Dóminus ex Sion: qui fecit caelum et terram. Allelúja.

How to sing the “Greater Alleluia” in Eastertide:

- (1) The first half of the word “Allelúja” is sung—the *Jubilus* is excluded.
 - (2) The full “Allelúja” is then sung —the *Jubilus* is sung.
 - (3) Then the verse of the FIRST ALLELUIA is sung, but the “Allelúja” is not repeated.
 - (4) The full “Allelúja” from the SECOND ALLELUIA is sung straight through, with no repeats.
 - (5) The verse of the SECOND ALLELUIA is sung.
 - (6) The “Allelúja” of the SECOND ALLELUIA is sung again straight through, with no repeats.
