HE CAMPION MISSAL appeared in 2012. It was thought that (perhaps) it might last four years—a virtual eternity in today's printing industry. The fact that it lasted *eight years* boggles the mind, considering the number of American printers & paper mills that have filed bankruptcy since 2015.

A third edition—a much lighter book, printed on lightweight paper—is scheduled for release in January of 2022. It will contain:

- (a) The "Pre-1955" Holy Week (...in addition to the 1962 version)
- **(b)** The "new" optional Prefaces (acc. to *Quo Magis*, issued 22 Febr 2020)
- (c) Several truly breathtaking surprises!

Our publisher is SOPHIA PRESS INSTITUTE, which is currently in charge of *Fraternity Publications* (the FSSP publishing house). When the Campion Missal was released in 2012, there was nothing like it; it was truly revolutionary for its time. The release of the new **Saint Jean de Brébeuf Hymnal** is quite an improvement upon the Campion hymnal—indeed, there's no comparison between them. For this reason, the 3rd edition of the Campion will not include hymnody. We have taken into consideration suggestions given to us over the last eight years.
