

 - these we will not hide *from their* children * but will tell them to the next generation:


the glories of the LORD *and his* might, * and the marvelous deeds he has done.

2. O let there be rejoic*ing and* gladness * for all *who* seek you.


Let them say forever, "God is great," * who love your saving help.

3. As for me, wretch*ed and* **poor**, * hasten to me, *O* **God**.


You are my rescu*er, my* help; * O LORD, do not *de*lay.


