





The hand of the Lord feeds us; he an-swers all our needs.

3 The LORD is just in all his ways and ho-ly in all his works.



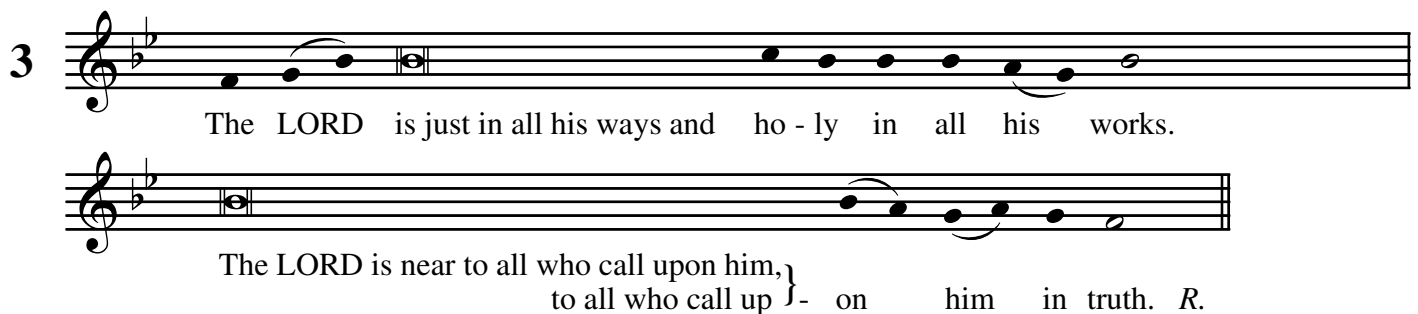
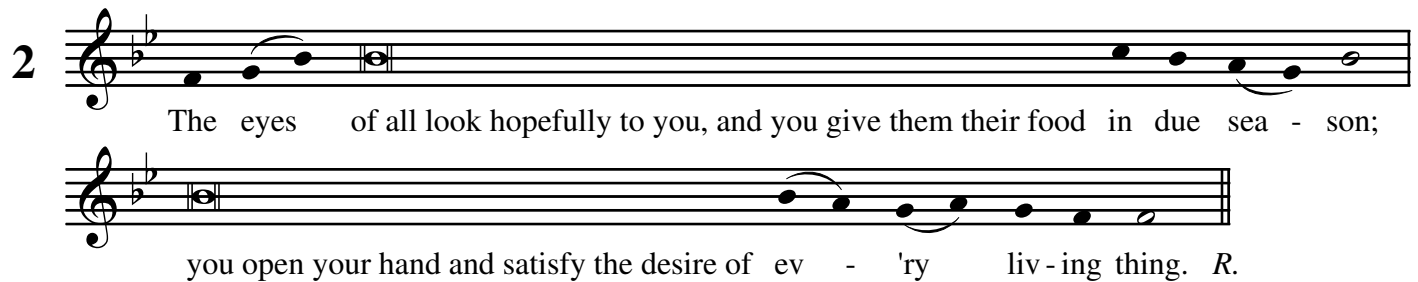
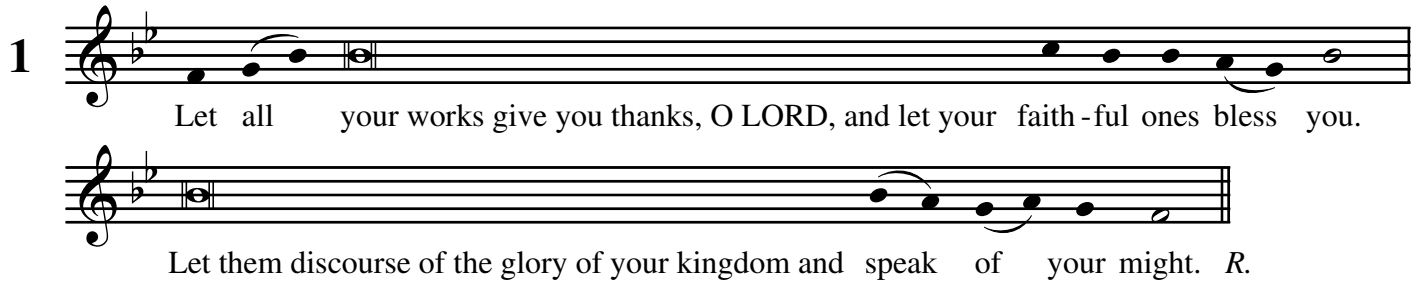
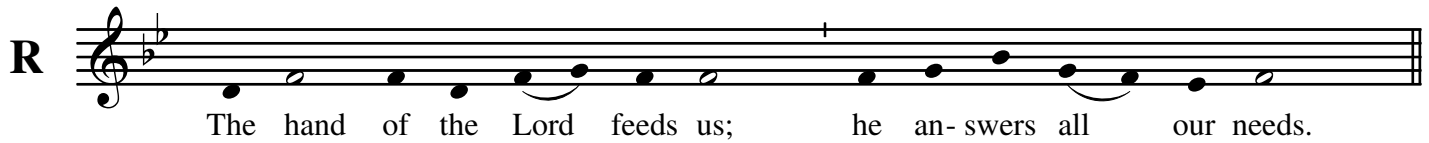
1 Let them discourse of the glory of your kingdom and speak of your might. R.
