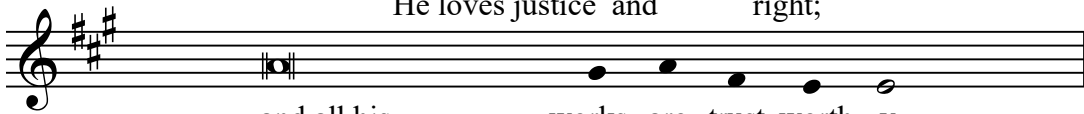

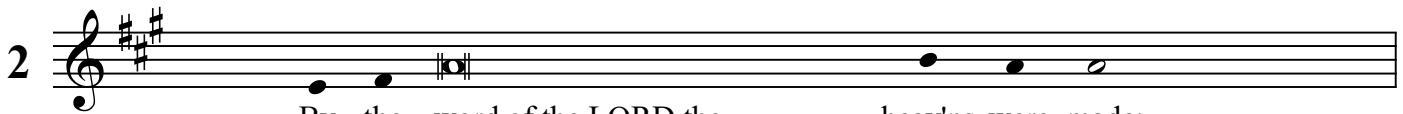

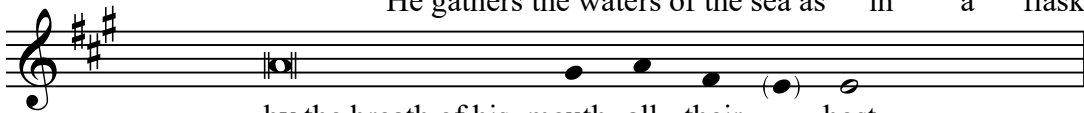
Up-right is the word of the LORD,  
He loves justice and right;



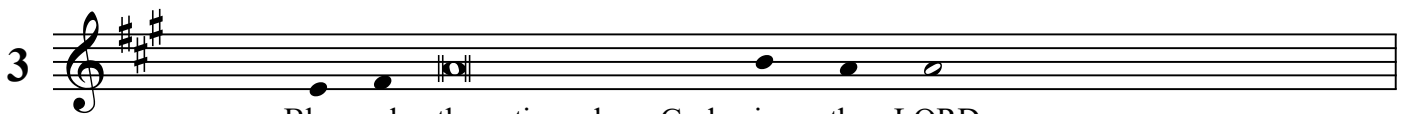
and all his works are trust-worth-y.  
of the kindness of the LORD the earth is full. *R.*



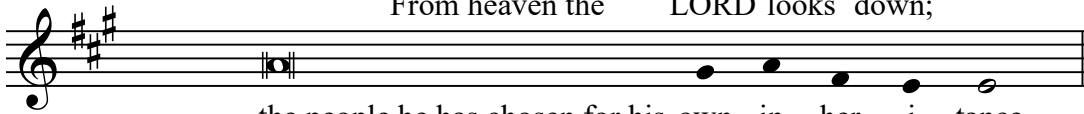
By the word of the LORD the heav'ns were made;  
He gathers the waters of the sea as in a flask;



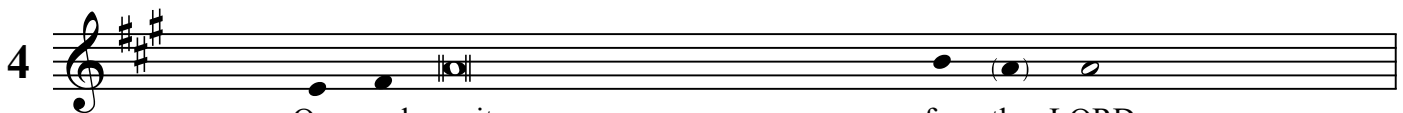
by the breath of his mouth all their host.  
in cellars he con-fines the deep. *R.*



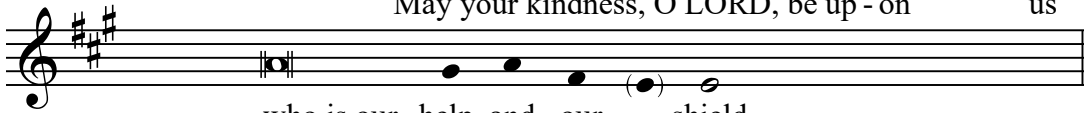
Bless-ed the nation whose God is the LORD,
