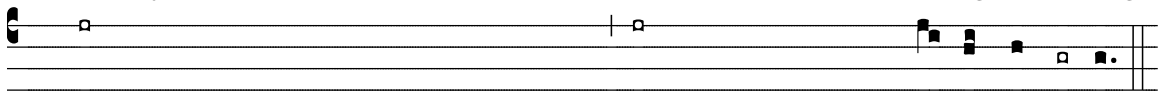
While he slew them they sought him and inquired *af-ter* God a-gain, Remembring



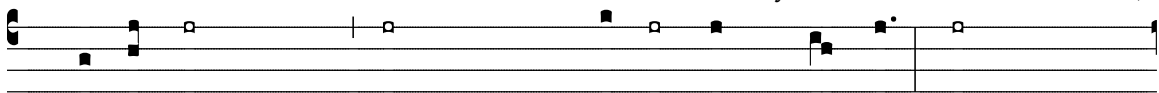
that God was their rock, and the Most High God, *their* re-dee-mer. R̃



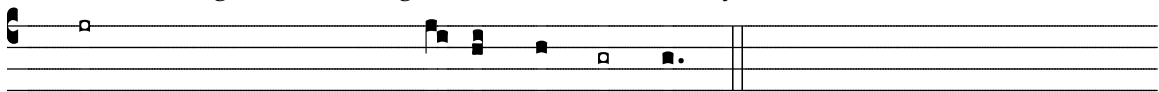
But they flattered him with their mouths and lied *to* him with their tongues, though
