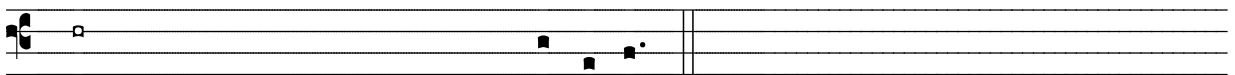
Gra-cious is the Lord and just; yes, our God is *mer*-ci-ful. The LORD keeps the little ones;
