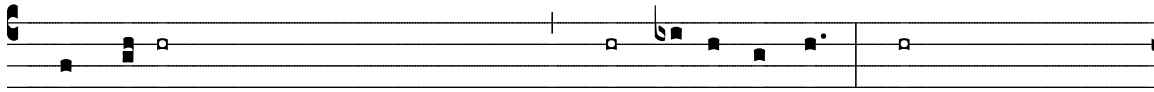
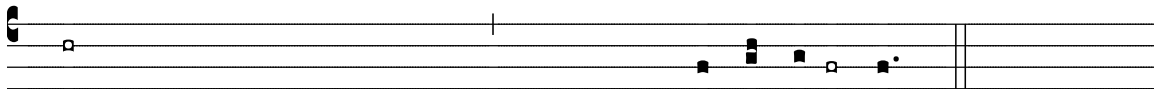

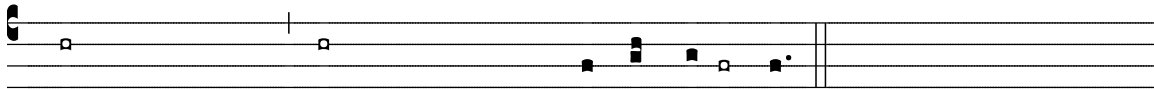
Bless-ed is he whose fault is taken away, whose *sin* is cov-ered. Blessed the man to



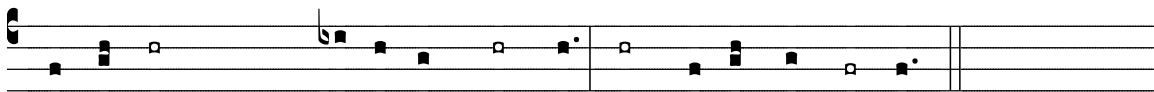
whom the LORD imputes not guilt, in whose spir-*it* there is no guile. R .
