

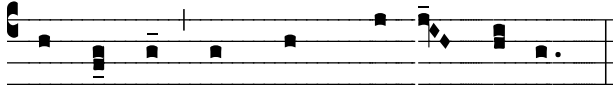

O bles-sed are those who fear the Lord.



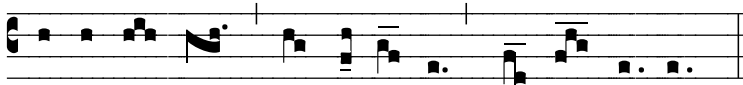
Blessed are/ you who fear the/ **LORD**, -- \* who/ walk in/ **his** ways!

--/Your children like/ **o**(live) plants \* a/*round* your/ **table**.

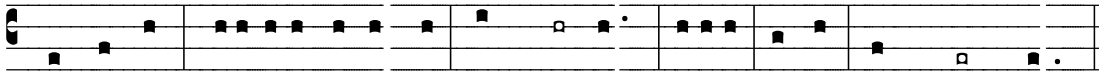
Behold, thus/ is the man blessed who fears the/ **LORD**. -- \* The LORD bless/ you from/ **Zi**-on:
