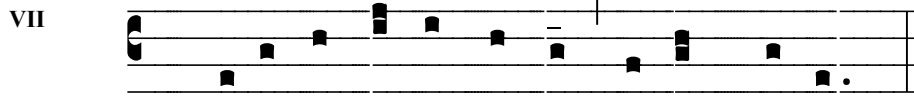


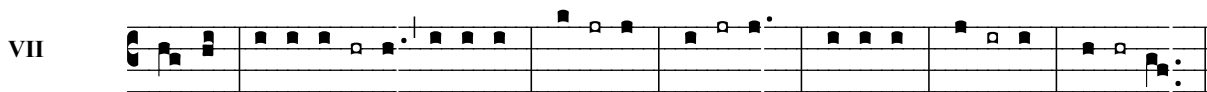
Responsorial Psalm Thirty-second Sunday (A) *Psalm 63: 2, 3-4, 5-6, 8-9*
