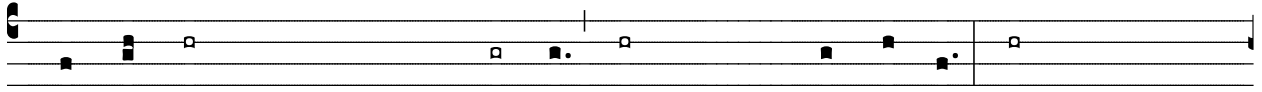


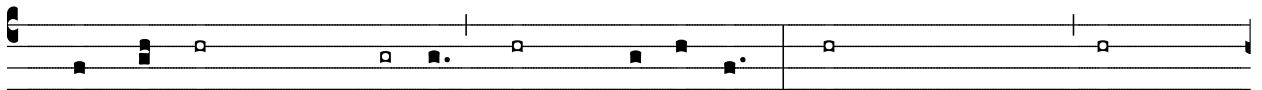
The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruit-ful har-vest.



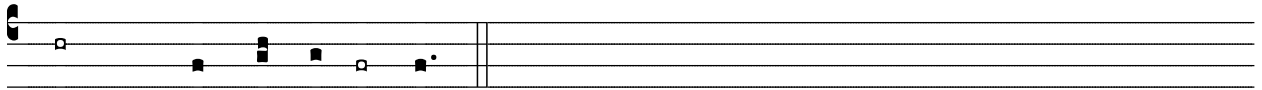
