



Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.




Shout joy-fully to God, all the earth, sing praise to the glory of his *name*; proclaim his




*glo-ri-ous* praise. Say to God, "how tre-men-dous are your deeds!" Rx




"Let all on earth worship and sing praise to you, sing praise to *your name*." Come and see




the works of God, his tremendous deeds among the chil-dren of Ad-am. Rx




He has changed the sea into dry land; through the river they passed on *foot*; therefore let us
