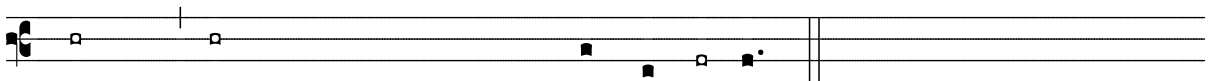
Ex-ult, you just, in the LORD; praise from the upright is *fit*-ting. Give thanks to the



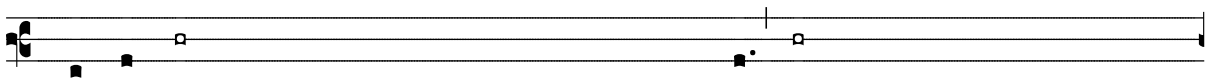

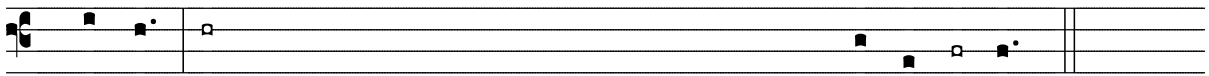
Up-right is the word of the LORD, and all his works are *trust*-wor-thy. He loves justice
