



We too labor, all day, and if we do not work for Our Lord we are working in vain. If we do the exact same work we are doing now, but offer it for the glory of God, the fruit from that very same work will be so immense that we would find it hard to believe.

In the monastery we would do a small thing before beginning any task. We would kneel down and say a Hail Mary. Then we would ask Our Blessed Mother for Her blessing, that the work we were about to do could be for the glory of God.

Then when we completed a task, we would say: "May it be for the glory of God!" One of the monks who died while I was there said that for his last words. Doesn't get better than that!
